CMAB awards Community Arts Support Grants to nineteen area arts organizations

The Central Minnesota Arts Board (CMAB), at their March 12, 2014 meeting, awarded nineteen Community Arts Support Grants totaling \$114,372.

The Community Arts Support Grant program provides funds equaling up to 15% of the last completed fiscal year's annual operating expenses or \$10,000, to nonprofit arts organizations located in Benton, Sherburne, Stearns or Wright County. Grants are awarded to organizations that demonstrate efficient management and programming of high artistic quality while enhancing arts opportunities within the communities they serve. These funds may be used for administrative, operating and capital expenditures.
