Organizations must serve residents in and individual applicants must reside in Benton, Sherburne, Stearns or Wright County.  
\*Guidelines and Applications are available online 60 days prior to deadline dates.

## ARTIST LEARNING GRANT

Funds for artists to attend a class, training or workshop and/or purchase equipment and supplies.  
\$500 grant maximum.

**ROLLING DEADLINE - JULY 11, 2023 - MAY 24, 2024**  
Applications are reviewed upon submission

## ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

Support for schools & organizations to engage professional artists to provide arts learning experiences. \$3,500 grant maximum.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE**  
**Wed., August 9, 2023**

## ARTIST CAREER DEVELOPMENT

Support for purchases, trainings, creation of work and other activities that respond to a compelling challenge or opportunity for individual artists. \$4,000 grant maximum.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE**  
**Thurs., August 10, 2023**

## PROJECT GRANT

Funds for projects that support access to the arts, arts education and arts & cultural heritage.  
\$8,000 grant maximum that include 10% matching funds.

**APPLICATION DEADLINES**  
**Rnd 1: Wed., September 6, 2023**  
**Rnd 2: Wed., February 28, 2024**

## TEACHING ARTIST GRANT

Funds for individuals listed on the Teaching Artist Roster in support of residencies in schools, nonprofit organizations and communities. \$2,000 grant maximum.

**APPLICATION DEADLINES**  
**Rnd 1: Thurs., October 19, 2023**  
**Rnd 2: Thurs., February 15, 2024**  
**Rnd 3: Thurs., May 16, 2024**

## ARTS ORGANIZATION DEVELOPMENT

Funds to support activities and purchases that contribute to organizational sustainability, growth and improvement or for arts groups seeking to obtain 501(c)(3) status.  
\$10,000 grant maximum.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE**  
**Wed., October 25, 2023**

## INDIVIDUAL ARTIST AWARD

Artists are invited to apply for a \$3,500 award each year and may receive up to \$5,000 in Individual Artist awards in a lifetime.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE**  
**Thurs., January 18, 2024**

## COMMUNITY ARTS SUPPORT

Biennial grant to support nonprofit arts organizations. Funds from \$3,000 to \$10,000 or 20% of the last annual operating expense distributed annually.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE**  
**Wed., January 24, 2024**

## STUDENT ARTS SCHOLARSHIP


Individuals pursuing their first undergraduate degree with an arts-related major may apply for a Scholarship and receive up to Four in a lifetime.

## PUBLIC ART GRANT

Support for the creation and installation of public art. No maximum grant request, proposals must include 25% matching funds.
